RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Geologist will be an integral member of the Mancal Energy exploration team. The successful candidate will have a history of new pool discoveries in western Canada in both clastic and carbonate reservoirs with low finding costs. The candidate will be responsible for the following:

- Independently generating prospects using reservoir models with detailed sedimentology, geophysics, and economics to support the concepts.
- Developing prospects using sound geologic and geophysical principles taking advantage of the most recent technologies available. It is expected that these plays where possible, will be followed through to the drilling stage with the intention of developing new core areas for the Corporation.
- Preparing government applications such as continuations, logging waivers and holdings.
- Developing strategies and forecasts pertaining to annual capital budgeting and presenting these plans to senior management.

QUALIFICATIONS:

To meet the challenge of this role, we are seeking a motivated, self-starter who works well under minimal supervision. This geologist will have a minimum of 10 years related oil and gas experience and be a member, or eligible for membership in APEGA. It is required that the successful candidate will have the following skills and experience:

- Sound understanding of the associated subsurface disciplines (geophysics, geochemistry, petrophysics, and structural geology).
- Strong working knowledge of AccuMap.
- Familiarity with the latest in drilling (both vertical and horizontal wells) and logging technologies is expected.
- Property evaluations and bid recommendations with supporting mapping and economics are required.
- Experience working independently at a small to mid-size oil company is preferred.
- Preference will be given to the candidate with light to medium gravity oil prospects which are immediately accessible and of a material size to Mancal.
- Willingness and ability to mentor co-workers in prospect generation and risk assessment.
- Candidates will have a proven track record of adding significant oil and gas reserves at respectable finding costs on their own internally generated prospects.
- Experience managing drilling operations for both vertical and horizontal wells is critical.
- Assisting the Engineering group with drilling plans, completion programs, reserve reports, and economic evaluations will be required.
- A high level of proficiency in both oral and written communication skills is also expected.
